Pricing is quoted in US\$. For the purpose of allocation of energy and cost of energy, price is converted to CAN\$ based on the Bank of Canada daily noon exchange rate.

On April 12, 2013 BC Hydro filed its 2012 Network Economy Annual report with the BCUC. During the first quarter the Threshold Purchase Price, used to allocate energy volumes to the Domestic system, was US -\$999/MWh. As described in BC Hydro's April 12, 2013 letter, incorrect data was used to calculate the Trigger Price and the Economic Test between April 6, 2012 and March 29, 2013. This error has been corrected and BC Hydro will ensure that future quarterly Network Economy reports and Economic Test results are based on consistent Threshold Purchase Price values.

³ A negative volume indicates net domestic exports during the month.

⁴ A positive volume indicates net domestic imports during the month.
