

BCTC is implementing the Order based on the following principles:

1. The actions taken with respect to service agreements in conjunction with Commission Order G-103-09, Letter L-95-09 and in consultation with Affected Customers, remain in effect.
2. Commission Order G-45-10 is incremental to Commission Order G-103-09.
3. The Long Term PTP Transmission queue will be re-established to reflect the situation as it existed on November 30, 2007.¹

BCTC will implement the Order in the following sequence:

1. BCTC will recall Cargill's transmission service of 25MW, effective April 1, 2010.
2. BCTC will ask BCPS to submit a new TSR for 25MW with a Start Date of April 1, 2010 with Buyer Comments: "Per Commission Order G-45-10". BCPS will need to match, at a minimum, a term of 4 years which is the duration of Cargill's original request.
3. To re-establish the queue order situation as it existed on November 30, 2007:
 - i. Cargill will be permitted to submit, by March 31st, a new TSR for 25MW with Buyer Comments: "Per Commission Order G-45-10" – Start Date will be April 1, 2010 and Stop Date will be determined by Cargill; and
 - ii. BCPS will be permitted to submit, by March 31st, a new TSR for 100MW with Buyer Comments: "Per Commission Order G-45-10" to displace existing TSR 72622381 of 120MW – Start Date will be April 1, 2010 and Stop Date will be determined by BCPS. This TSR will follow Cargill's request in the queue.

BCTC will coordinate the implementation of the Order with Cargill and BCPS. Once it has been implemented, BCTC will post the Long Term PTP Transmission queue.
