
## Home Renovation Rebates Receipt Requirements

Receipts need to have all the information identified in the list below in order to meet the program requirements. A pre-upgrade EnerGuide home evaluation must be completed before the installation of draftproofing upgrades. A post-upgrade EnerGuide home evaluation must also be completed after the installation of these upgrades. - 2 Contractor's contact information
- 3 Invoice number
- 4 Date of installation & purchase
- 5 Homeowner/Customer name & address
- 6 In the areas of the house where draftproofing was completed, indicate the following:
  - Draftproofing location(s): List all locations with details, for example: attic hatch, top floor pot lights, ceiling penetrations, back door, front main floor windows, exhaust vent(s), etc.
  - List materials used. A range of materials are acceptable, including weather stripping, caulking, expanding foam, drywall, plywood, concrete, poly, etc. If an unusual product was used, briefly describe where/how it was used.
- 7 Cost (including labour)
- Proof of payment or payment plan (e.g. PAID stamp)
