
Home Renovation Rebates Receipt Requirements

- 1 Contractor's company name & address
- 2 Contractor's contact information
- 3 Invoice number
- 4 Date of installation & purchase
- 5 Homeowner/Customer name & address
- In each area of the house that has been upgraded and/or had a different insulation treatment, indicate the following:
 - Location of upgrade (attic; wall cavities; wall sheating; basement/crawlspace walls; exposed floor; joist header; floor above crawlspace)
 - **6B** Type of insulation used
 - 6C Starting & final R-value added
 - 6D Total amount added in square feet
- 7 Cost (including labour)
- Proof of payment or payment plan (e.g. PAID stamp)
