

INTERIOR TO LOWER MAINLAND TRANSMISSION PROJECT HELICOPTER WORK

Construction work for the new 247 kilometre 500 kilovolt transmission line between Merritt and Coquitlam continues. Current activities are focused on:

- Vegetation and tree clearing along the right-of-way
- Tower foundation installations

As part of this work, helicopters are required and currently in service in some areas along the right-of-way south and east of Harrison Hot Springs. The contractor has obtained the necessary permits and permissions and is in compliance with Transport Canada requirements. Wherever possible, helicopters follow routes and schedules that minimize disturbances to residents.

The ILM project will expand the capacity of the transmission system that brings power from generation sources in the North and Southern Interior so that BC Hydro can continue to deliver clean and reliable energy to homes and businesses in the Lower Mainland and Vancouver Island.
