

**Spirit of BC Family Skate, presented by BC Hydro
Vancouver 2010 Winter Games prize pack contest**

**British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (“BC Hydro”) and 2010 Legacies Now
 (“Legacies”)**

Official Contest Rules

1. The Vancouver 2010 Winter Games ticket prize pack contest (the “Contest”) is open to any B.C. resident age 19 or over who meets all the conditions of these rules. The Contest begins at 9:00 AM (Pacific Time) on February 6, 2009, and closes at 5:00 PM (Pacific Time) on February 28, 2009 (the “Contest Period”).
2. **How to Participate** – There are two ways to enter the contest:
 - a) Attend a free-admission Spirit of BC Family Skate event (visit www.bchydro.com or www.spiritofbc.com for event locations and times) in communities within the BC Hydro service area (see map at www.bchydro.com/about/our_system.html and click “serves customers in an area” pdf document), complete the Team Power Smart pledge form (available from a BC Hydro Outreach representative or at the Power Smart booth), including a special promotional code which will be available at Spirit of BC Family Skate events, and deposit it in the entry box located at the BC Hydro Power Smart booth at the event;
 - b) If an on-site entry form is not available at an event or an eligible participant chooses to enter online, they must visit www.bchydro.com to Join Team Power Smart and enter the special promotional code received at a Family Skate event (promotional code: SKATE2009).
 - c) If an entrant has already joined Team Power Smart before the start of the Contest Period, then that entrant may enter the contest by logging in to their BC Hydro online account and entering special promotional code received at a Family Skate event. Multiple entries will be counted as one entry.
4. By submitting an entry, entrants acknowledge that they have read, understood and agreed to abide by these Official Contest Rules.
5. **Random Draw** – A random draw will be held on **March 6, 2009**, to select one entry from all eligible entries received through all methods of entry. The chances of winning depend upon the total number of eligible entries received.
6. **Prize** – There is one (1) grand prize available to be won, consisting of four tickets to a 2010 Olympic Winter Games event. Exact event will be determined by BC Hydro in its sole and exclusive discretion and event details, date/time and location will be provided to winner in advance. Prize includes a maximum \$2000 contribution towards return economy class airfare for four (4) persons from the commercial airport nearest the winner's home to the lower mainland and one (1) night standard hotel accommodation in the lower mainland based on quadruple occupancy. For winners living within 200 kilometres of the lower mainland or in a location where ground transportation is

more appropriate and practical as determined by BC Hydro in its sole and exclusive discretion, prize travel will include ground transportation from the winner's home to the lower mainland and no air travel will be included. All other costs associated with the use by the winner and his/her guests of the prize, including but not limited to meals, beverages, items of a personal nature, transportation not described above as included in the prize and additional accommodation-related charges over and above base room charges, are the responsibility of the winner. The approximate value of the prize will vary based on the point of departure and price fluctuations and is estimated, including event tickets, to have a maximum prize value of \$4200.

7. **Notification** – The selected entrant will be notified by telephone/email. To be declared a winner, the selected entrant must correctly answer, without assistance of any kind, whether mechanical or otherwise, a mathematical skill-testing question. At least five attempts over the five business days following the draw will be made to contact the selected entrant. If the selected entrant cannot be contacted in this manner, that entrant will be disqualified and another entrant will be selected from the remaining eligible entrants. BC Hydro is not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever, including their own negligence, of a selected entrant to receive notification or for BC Hydro to receive a selected entrant's response. Before being declared a winner, the selected entrant must sign a declaration and release form to (a) accept the prize as awarded and confirm their eligibility and compliance with these rules; (b) release, waive and forever discharge all right, in contract or tort, to damages against BC Hydro, Legacies and their affiliates and agents for any loss or injury sustained as a result of accepting the prize; and (c) consent to the use of his/her name, address, photograph or likeness for any publicity purpose connected with this Contest, without any further compensation, other than the prize offered. Winner's travelling companions (or their parent/legal guardian if they are under the age of majority) will also be required to sign liability/publicity release forms prior to travel.
8. **Eligibility** – No purchase necessary. The Contest is open to B.C. residents who are 19 years of age or older as at the start of the contest. One entry per household. Employees of BC Hydro and its affiliates, Legacies and their advertising or promotional agencies involved with this Contest, and persons with whom such employees reside, will not be eligible. In any event, BC Hydro shall have exclusive discretion to deem which entries are valid and meet all the conditions of these rules.
9. **Miscellaneous** – Entrants who have not complied with these Official Contest Rules are subject to disqualification at the exclusive discretion of BC Hydro. Prize is not transferable and must be accepted as awarded with no substitutions in cash or otherwise, except as provided by these rules or at BC Hydro's sole and exclusive discretion. BC Hydro reserves the right to substitute a prize of equivalent value if the prize cannot be awarded as described and to exercise discretion with respect to travel expense contribution. All decisions of BC Hydro are final in all matters relating to this Contest. No correspondence will be entered into by BC Hydro with respect to this Contest, except with the selected entrant. BC Hydro reserves the right to terminate or amend this Contest at any time without prior notice, if it considers that any factor may potentially interfere with its proper conduct as contemplated by these Official Contest Rules. This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws.
10. BC Hydro is not responsible for entries lost, misdirected, illegible, or delayed for any reason whatsoever. BC Hydro is not responsible for any problems or technical

malfunction of any telephone or cell phone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, computer equipment, software, failure of any text message or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the text messaging system, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's cell phone, related to or resulting from this Contest. BC Hydro reserve the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel or suspend this Contest should a virus, bug, or other cause beyond the reasonable control of BC Hydro to corrupt the security or proper administration of the Contest.

11. All entries become the property of BC Hydro and will not be returned. All intellectual property, including but not limited to trademarks and copyright, and all of the promotional materials associated with the Contest, are owned by BC Hydro. All rights are reserved. Copying or unauthorized use of any copyrighted material or trademarks without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.
