Words and phrases defined in the RFP and used in this Addendum have the meanings given in the RFP, unless otherwise defined herein. References to section numbers mean sections of the RFP, unless otherwise specified.

1. **Process Documents Reissued with Corrections**

The following process documents are re-issued and posted with this Addendum. Documents are posted in clean and black-lined form, except as noted:

- Commercial Proposal form (Schedule 9), in clean form only. The following amendments have been made:
 - Item #8 has been corrected to read “The Post-COD escalation should not be greater than 50% and should not be less than 0%”.
 - For Items #12, #13, #14, and #15, the completion guidelines have been amended to include guidance on the correct units to be used.
- Project Description Requirements (Schedule 10), in clean form only. The following amendments have been made:
 - In subsection 2.4(d) the sentence “Detailed plans identifying the proposed interconnection right of way should be included as an Exhibit to the Project Description” has been deleted and subsection 2.4(f) has been added.
 - Subsection 2.11(c) has been amended to read:

Provide a description, chronology, and status report on all First Nations consultations and engagement conducted and planned by the Proponent relative to the Project, including particulars of issues identified and how each issue has been or will be addressed.
- Specimen EPA.

The Specimen EPA has been revised to incorporate a few corrections/clarifications and to add a new section dealing with “remedial action schemes” (section 7.12).

2. **Hourly Firm Credit Table**

The Hourly Firm Credit Table, which is set out below, serves two purposes.

Section 18 of the RFP indicates that an “Hourly Firm Adjustment” will be applied to levelized Firm Energy Prices in the course of Proposal evaluation. The magnitude of the adjuster (expressed in \$/MWh) will depend on the Proponent’s profile of on-peak hourly Firm Energy, with a “flat” profile yielding an adjuster of approximately \$4.00/MWh. The actual adjustment will be derived by applying the Hourly Firm Credit Table.

Section 1 of the EPA Adaptations Guide sets out modifications to the Specimen EPA that are required to adapt it to an hourly Firm Energy product. These modifications include an adjustment to the Liquidated Damages (LDs) formulae as illustrated by the example posted to the RFP Website. The formulae include an Hourly Firm Credit (HFC) variable that will be derived from the Hourly Firm Credit Table.

3. **Correction to RFP, section 20.10**

Section 20.10 is corrected to read:

BC Hydro, in its sole and unfettered discretion, may decline to consider a Proposal, or may disqualify the Proponent, or may rescind the award of an EPA if the Proponent is in violation of the terms of the Confidentiality and Compliance Agreement.
