GENERAL DUAL FUEL INTERRUPTIBLE ELECTRIC SERVICE AGREEMENT made the
_____ day of _____ 19 ____.

BETWEEN:

(the "Customer")

AND:

British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority
("B.C. Hydro")

1. In this agreement:
"Customer's Premises" means the premises located at _____
"Extension Cost" means the estimated cost of the extension.
"Biennial Date" means the second anniversary of the day on which service was energized under this Agreement.
"Revenue" means only those charges directly resulting from the application of the Electric Tariff Rate Schedule under which service is provided hereunder and does not include any taxes, interest charges, late payment charges, power factor surcharges or other miscellaneous charges.
2. B.C. Hydro will deliver interruptible electricity for use on the Customer's premises and the Customer shall pay according to the following terms.
3. The supply of electricity shall be alternating current _____ phase _____ wire, having a frequency of approximately 60 hertz metered at a nominal potential of _____ volts and delivered at a nominal potential of _____ volts at the Point of Delivery, subject to normal variations from the said frequency and voltages.
4. Electricity is supplied and taken upon and subject to the terms and conditions from time to time contained in B.C. Hydro's Electric Tariff and at the rate set out in Rate Schedule _____, or any replacement thereof, in the said Electric Tariff which is available for inspection at any general office of B.C. Hydro. A copy of Rate Schedule _____ in effect as of the date of this Agreement is attached.
5. B.C. Hydro owns, and is responsible for the maintenance of, only the following electrical equipment installed or to be installed on the Customer's premises:
 - meters and metering transformers for the purpose of billing. (Insert list of applicable equipment.)

6. The load shall be limited to _____ kW of maximum demand consisting of the following equipment and shall not be increased or added to without the prior written approval of B.C. Hydro. The listed equipment shall be energized only through the metering equipment applicable to this rate.

7. Where an extension is required B.C. Hydro will install an extension to the Customer's premises, the specifications of which extension shall be in the sole discretion of B.C. Hydro, and the Customer shall pay on or before the Biennial Date any balance yet unpaid on the Extension Cost, less any amount paid as Revenue. The Extension Cost for this Agreement is \$ _____. (Where there is no extension insert NIL as the Extension Cost.)

8. The initial term of this Agreement shall be _____ year(s) from the date the service is energized.

9. Upon expiration of the initial term this Agreement will be continued on a year to year basis unless terminated on the anniversary date by either party providing one month's prior written notice to the other party and, if prior to the Biennial Date, the Customer paying the unpaid balance of the Extension Cost stated in paragraph 7.

10. The Customer acknowledges his right to inspect a copy of B.C. Hydro's Electric Tariff and agrees that such right is sufficient notice of the rates and terms it contains. The Customer further specifically acknowledges the terms and conditions of service included in Rate Schedule _____. In particular the Customer agrees to B.C. Hydro's right to interrupt service at the discretion of B.C. Hydro.

11. The Customer agrees to have and maintain an alternative heating system using an alternative fuel supplied from a Customer owned or rented storage facility, for use during periods of interruption, in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Rate Schedule _____.

12. The Customer agrees that B.C. Hydro has the right of access as provided for in Rate Schedule _____.
