1. This Addendum is issued pursuant to the BC Hydro Call for Tenders for Capacity and Associated Energy Supply on Vancouver Island, issued 31 October 2003, as amended (“CFT”).
2. Words and phrases defined in the CFT and used herein have the meanings given in the CFT, unless otherwise indicated. Refer to Appendix 1 of the CFT for definitions.
3. **Revised QEM Issued:** The QEM has been revised, is issued and posted with this Addendum in clean and blacklined form, and is available at <http://www.bchydro.com/vicft>. The blacklined form of the QEM shows changes from the prior version issued 14 July 2004. The purpose of this re-issuance is to provide clarity only. Specifically, it clarifies the manner in which transmission losses are addressed for purposes of Portfolio Assembly and determining Network Effects. The amendment to the QEM described in Addendum 20 paragraph 3 is also incorporated into the version of the QEM issued with this Addendum. The revised QEM issued with this Addendum consolidates the quantitative evaluation methodology, and accordingly supercedes and cancels all prior versions and Addenda, which describe the quantitative evaluation methodology, or any part thereof.
4. **Final Form EPA:** A revised Final Form EPA was issued with Addendum 20, dated 30 July 2004. **No further form of EPA is issued with this Addendum.** However, bidders are advised that, consistent with section 1 of the CFT, all references to the Final Form EPA in the CFT, prior Addenda, the Tender Form, the Agreement Information Form or the Price Information Form or any other document related to the CFT shall be deemed to be references to the revised Final Form EPA, issued with Addendum 20.
5. **Tender Form:** To enable flexibility in the execution of the Tender Form, the Tender Form has been revised, is issued and posted with this Addendum, and is available at <http://www.bchydro.com/vicft>. There are no substantive changes in this version of the Tender Form. Rather the execution block has been released from “form-field protection” in order to allow bidders to select and complete the execution blocks in the manner described in the Tender Form General Instructions and in accordance with their particular corporate structure and internal policies. Bidders must not make any changes to the Tender Form execution block other than is required to comply with the foregoing sentence. Bidders should delete execution blocks inapplicable to the corporate structure of the bidder.
