Invitation to Transmission Services and Pricing Workshops

Workshop 1 : Introduction to the Existing WTS Tariff	
Content:	This session will provide introductory-level information on the existing Wholesale Transmission Services tariff. It will cover such issues as tariff language, definition, services, and role structure. It will also provide a high level overview of the service request and transmission reservation process.
Attendees:	This workshop is aimed at those participants who have had very little previous experience in using BCTC's transmission services.

Workshop 2: Transmission Issues in BC	
Content:	This session will cover emerging issues in transmission services and pricing. It will address some of the most critical decisions that need to be covered in redesigning BC's WTS tariff, and will examine how other jurisdictions have managed these challenges.
Attendees:	This workshop is aimed at both potential and existing users of transmission services in BC, who wish to gain a greater understanding of the transmission tariff.
