Re: BC Hydro Revenue Requirements 2004/2005 and 2005/2006 Application

Dear Sir:

In regards to the above noted Application, I have the following Supplementary Information Request to my IR 2.1.0, which is restated below:

In your answer to BCUC IR 1.2.26 with the Table "Domestic Energy Costs F1994-F2002", the line labeled 'Hydro Generation' directly under the Heading "\$/MW-h", apparently includes only the cost of Water Fees.

1. Provide a revised version of the entire section under the "\$/MW-h" heading with all costs (water fees, OMA, interest, return on equity, etc) charged to domestic hydro power production and also to do the same for the natural gas generation and the non-integrated areas generation for all of BC Hydro's self generated power.

The answer that I received does not allow me to isolate the \$/MW-h for the Hydro self-generated power. The BCUC IR 1.2.26, deals with total energy costs, while BCUC IR 1.5.3, deals with only the Heritage Obligation portion of the total power. The natural gas for thermal generation does not include plant asset, gas transport and staffing costs.

Please provide the complete information, separated into the types of generation as requested originally.
