

**Addendum #1 February 2, 2009 to: Kinbasket Reservoir Rainbow Trout Life History  
and Habitat Use Assessment (CLBMON-7) dated 24 October 2007**

**A1.1 Addendum Rationale**

As specified in the Columbia WUP Order (dated 26 January 2007), BC Hydro submitted Terms of Reference for the Kinbasket Reservoir Rainbow Trout Life History and Habitat Use Assessment. On 03 December 2007, the Comptroller of Water Rights (CWR) provided Leave to Commence with the work. The approved implementation and management costs assumed that the program would commence in 2009, and would be carried out over three years.

Since receiving approval on the study Terms of Reference, it has come to our attention that some of the work under the Columbia River Water Use Plan would need to be deferred due to internal resource constraints. Given that the rainbow trout assessment in Kinbasket Reservoir is not integral to successful delivery of other WUP work being conducted in the region and results are not required until the WUP review in 2021, BC Hydro is proposing that implementation be delayed until 2014.

No other changes are required to the Terms of Reference.

**A1.2 Budget**

As a result of this change in schedule, the annual budgets have increased slightly reflecting the 2% rate of inflation that is applied to each implementation year.. Overall, the implementation of the monitoring program is expected to cost \$480,344 (including 2% rate of inflation and 5% contingency) over the three years of study, as compared to the approved budget of \$435,062.
