Re: BC Hydro Energy Supply Contract Filing

Pursuant to section 71 of the *Utilities Commission Act* (the Act) and the Commission's Rules regarding Electricity Supply Contracts (the Rules), BC Hydro is pleased to enclose for filing with the Commission the following electricity purchase agreements (the Agreements), and amendments thereto:

With the exception of item 16 (Enterprise Creek), BC Hydro is also filing the Agreements on behalf of the counterparties to them.

With this filing BC Hydro has now filed all the electricity purchase agreements to which it is a party, except those exempted from filing pursuant to an order under section 22 of the Act. Because the Agreements are subject to review in the context of the Commission's consideration of BC Hydro's Resource Expenditure and Acquisition Plan, BC Hydro believes that no public hearing into the Agreements pursuant to section 71 of the Act is necessary or desirable.


BC Hydro and the counterparties to the Agreements request that pursuant to section 1.9 of the Rules the Agreements and Appendix A be kept confidential.

BC Hydro will also be providing copies of this letter to intervenors and participants in the current revenue requirement proceeding.

Finally, BC Hydro also takes the opportunity to file three additional amendments to the McNair Creek agreement (item "1" in BC Hydro's January 13 filing).
