

**BC Hydro  
RC Standards of Conduct – Listing of Transfers of Employees**

Notices of any employee transfer to or from RELIABILITY COORDINATOR functions must be reported on the RELIABILITY COORDINATOR web site. The information to be posted must include:

- the name of the transferring employee
- the respective titles held while performing each function (i.e., on behalf of the RELIABILITY COORDINATOR, marketing function or transmission provider, or marketing function or transmission affiliate), and the effective date of the transfer.

The information posted under this section must remain on the RELIABILITY COORDINATOR web site for 90 days.
