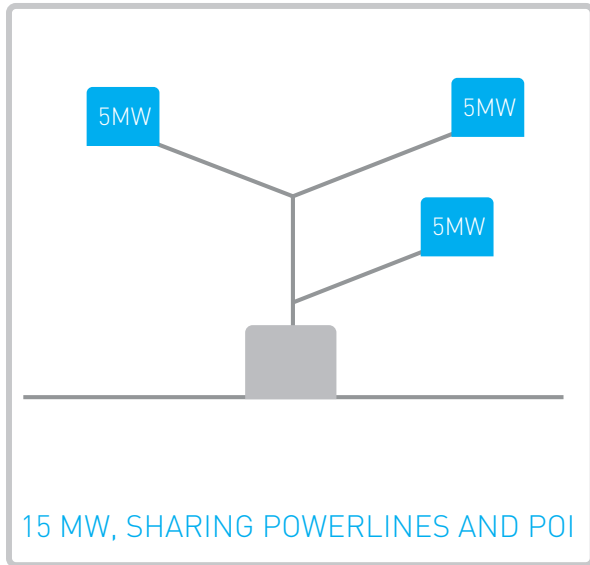


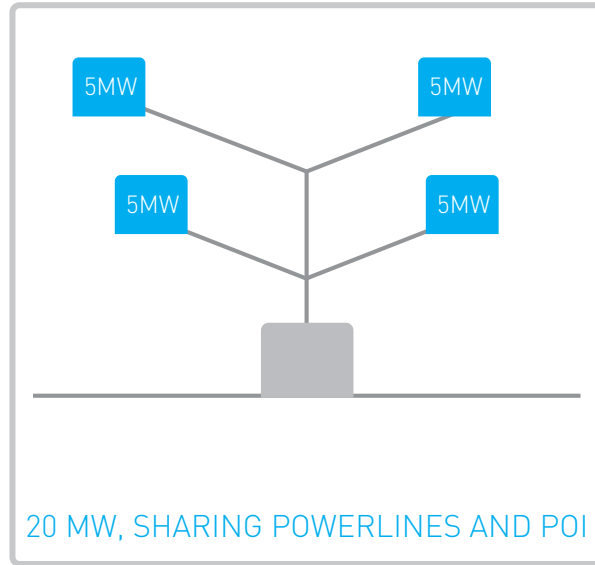
STANDING OFFER PROGRAM: PROJECT CLUSTERING CONFIGURATIONS

SCENARIO ONE:



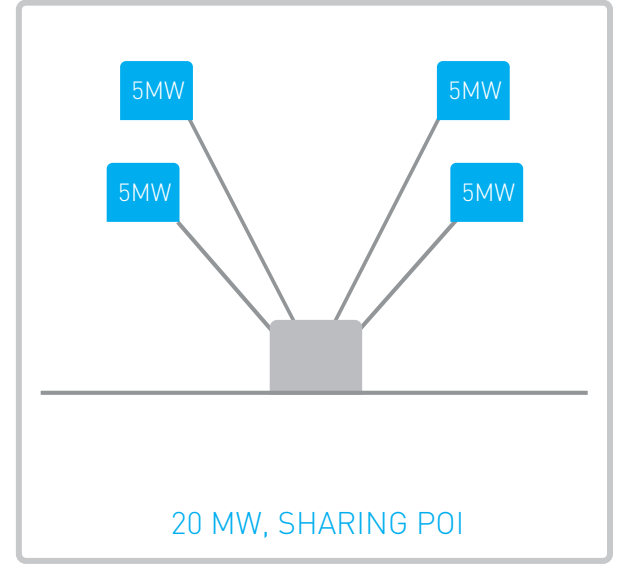
Eligible, the cluster doesn't exceed 15 MW.

SCENARIO TWO:



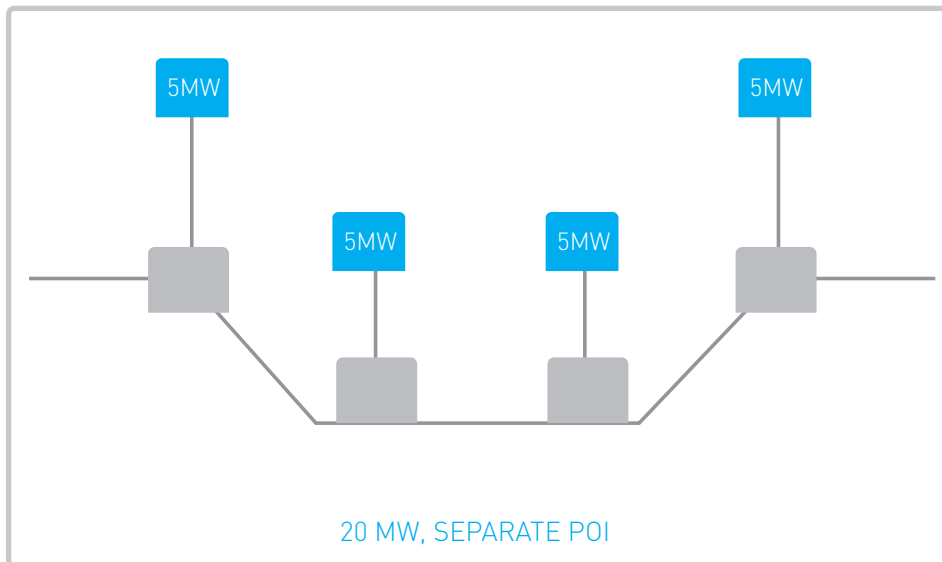
Not eligible, the cluster exceeds 15 MW and shares powerlines and point of interconnection.

SCENARIO THREE:



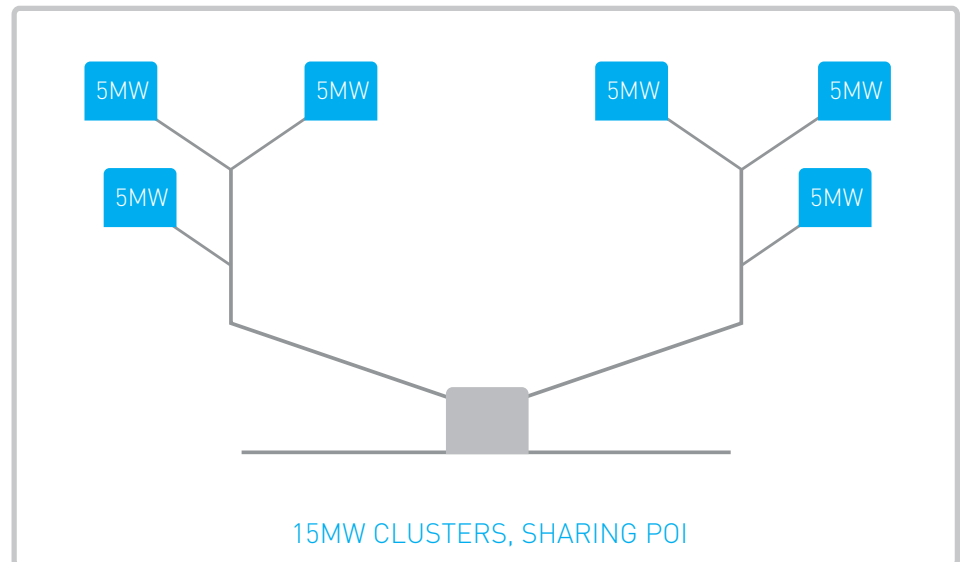
Not eligible, the cluster exceeds 15 MW and shares a point of interconnection.

SCENARIO FOUR:



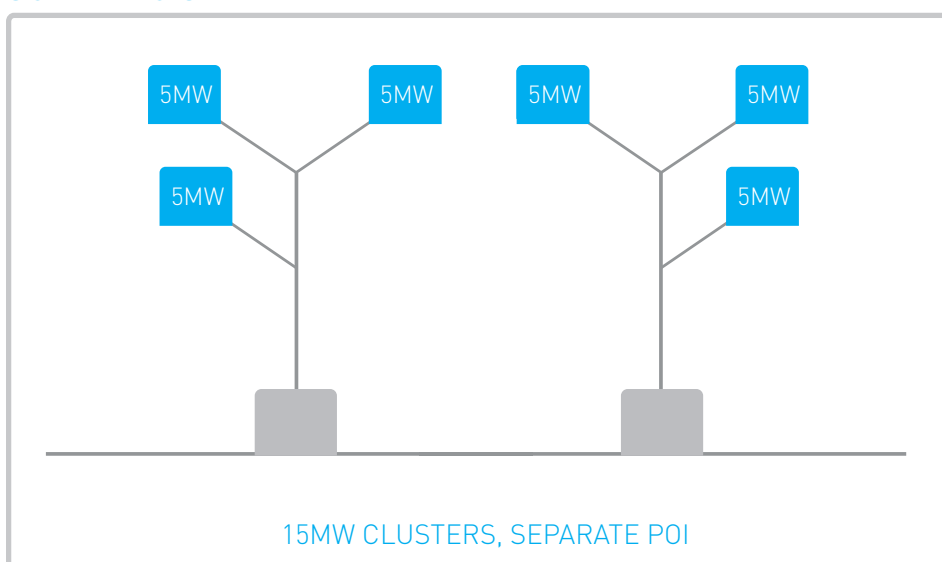
May or may not be eligible. Eligibility will depend on whether BC Hydro considers in its discretion that any tenures, permits, facilities, or other infrastructure were separated for the purpose of complying with the SOP eligibility requirements. Developers may request an optional preliminary assessment.

SCENARIO FIVE:



Not eligible, the cluster exceeds 15 MW and shares a point of interconnection.

SCENARIO SIX:



As with scenario four, the projects may or may not be eligible. Developers may request an optional preliminary assessment.
