**RE: British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC or Commission)  
British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro)  
Energy Supply Contract Filing Requirements – Fiscal 2026, Quarter 3**

---

BC Hydro writes in respect of its Amendments and Contractual Developments relating to its energy supply contracts (**Electricity Purchase Agreements** or **EPAs**) for the period from October 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025 (**Q3 Fiscal 2026**). BC Hydro files these reports and makes determinations about whether agreements it enters into, or other developments under an energy supply contract, are “Amendments” or “Contractual Developments” in accordance with the Rules for Energy Supply Contracts for Electricity (**Rules**).

We have also considered BCUC Order No. G-148-20, the subsequent clarification to the Order provided in the letter dated August 28, 2020, and BCUC Order No. G-279-20 with respect to the reconsideration and variance of BCUC Order No. G-148-20. We have particularly considered the directive in BCUC Order No. G-148-20, as varied by BCUC Order No. G-279-20, that “BC Hydro file future agreements that are associated with and materially affect existing EPAs”, and BCUC Order No. G-269-22 that requires BC Hydro “to file all amendments to [Energy Supply Contracts] with the BCUC by April 30 of each year including all contractual developments with their relevant details” (the **Directives**).

As with past practice for our quarterly reports, we are reporting EPA Amendments and Contractual Developments for Non-Exempt EPAs and Exempt EPAs. In addition, as has been the practice since February 2021, we are continuing to report and file for information those agreements that are associated with and materially affect existing EPAs (for both Non-Exempt and Exempt EPAs), to the extent there are any agreements to report for Q3 Fiscal 2026.

For ease of administration and consistency, there is one attached summary table for Non-Exempt EPAs (summarizing EPA Amendments and Contractual Developments), provided as Attachment 1, and a separate attached summary table for Exempt EPAs (summarizing EPA Amendments and Contractual Developments), provided as Attachment 2. As noted in the attached summary tables, those agreements associated

with, and that materially affect, an existing EPA are included for information, as applicable.

### **Confidentiality**

The Summaries of EPA Amendments and Contractual Developments (for Non-Exempt EPAs and Exempt EPAs), including any attachments related to each of these summaries, contain confidential, commercially sensitive information. This information, if publicly disclosed, may be harmful to the Seller Company and/or BC Hydro (e.g., if such information is publicly available, it may impact the financial position of the Seller or may potentially negatively impact BC Hydro's management of its IPP portfolio).

Accordingly, BC Hydro has redacted confidential information in the public versions of Attachments 1 and 2, with the unredacted, confidential versions being provided solely to the BCUC. BC Hydro requests that all of the confidential information within the Attachments remain confidential pursuant to the General Rule 1.10 of the Rules for Energy Supply Contracts for Electricity, Part IV of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, and section 42 of the *Administrative Tribunals Act*. BC Hydro further requests that the information be held confidential on an ongoing basis, until otherwise ordered by the BCUC.
