## BC Hydro Request to Depart from Major Project Capital Filing Guidelines for the Surrey Langley Skytrain Electrical Servicing Project

BC Hydro's 2018 Capital Filing Guidelines (2018 Guidelines) include BC Hydro's commitment to file an application for a Certificate of Public Necessity and Convenience (CPCN) for power system extension projects that have an authorized cost of greater than \$100 million prior to construction.

On April 5, 2024, BC Hydro requested to depart from the 2018 Guidelines and not file a CPCN application for its Surrey Langley Skytrain Electrical Servicing Project. The project costs exceed the \$100 million threshold. If the request is granted, BC Hydro would not be required to submit a separate major project application to the BCUC for approval, and the project costs would be reviewed in a revenue requirement application.
