BC Hydro Transmission Service Rate Design Application

On March 16, 2023, BC Hydro and Power Authority (BC Hydro) applied to the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) for approval of a proposal to transition Rate Schedule 1823 and Rate Schedule 1827 customers to a new, flat-rate structure – Rate Schedule 1830 – with a lower energy charge and higher demand charge over a three-year transition period.

BC Hydro indicates that the proposed new rate would be a revenue-neutral, flat-rate design as the default rate for Transmission service customers that incorporates feedback from customers and stakeholders and improves alignment with BC Hydro's cost of service and levelized marginal cost of energy.

In its review of the application, the BCUC will explore how the proposed Rate Schedule 1830 will impact BC Hydro's Transmission service customers.
