

1. Maintain your Limits of Approach.



Ensure there is a Safety
Protection Guarantee or
Lockout in place and check that
it is appropriate for your work.



3. Test for hazardous energy.



4. Ensure that WorkerProtection Grounding/Bonding is applied.



 Prevent harmful exposure to known carcinogens, toxins and bio-hazards.



5. Protect yourself from falling when working at height.



8. Don't work while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



6. Maintain a safe atmosphere in a confined space and ensure you can be rescued.



 Adjust your driving to the weather and road conditions.
