BC Hydro property has been vandalized with graffiti and has been damaged.

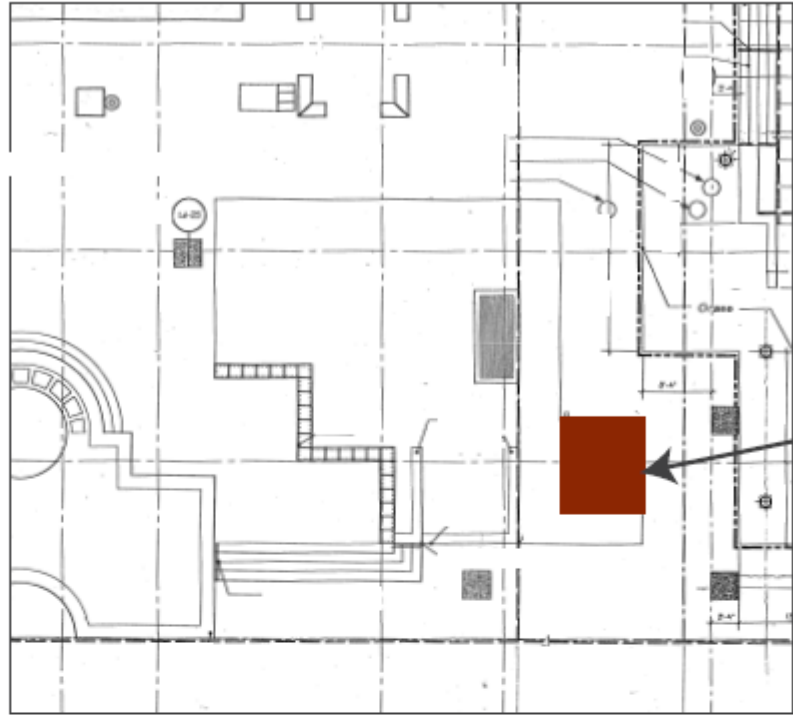
You are impeding, obstructing and interfering with access to the building by BC Hydro employees and members of the public coming to or leaving the building.

You are only permitted in the designated area between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. You must vacate the designated area completely after 7 p.m. every day and take any personal belongings with you when you vacate the BC Hydro property.

You must remove all of your tents, tarps, canopies and structures from the BC Hydro property immediately today. You also must remove immediately any signs from the property if those signs are outside of the designated area.
