

Job Aid: Logon to Citrix

Introduction

The purpose of this job aid is to describe the steps needed to logon to BC Hydro systems and network using Citrix.

Due to a change in the method of multifactor authentication, a change to the Citrix logon page(s) is necessary. This document will describe how users can login to Citrix from a web browser using either Microsoft Authenticator or RSA.

Page 1: Username and password entry

Open Browser and navigate to https://citrix.bchydro.com
Note: Users within the BC Hydro network don't need to use MFA to access Citrix.



- 2. Enter your username and password into the fields show above. This is the first factor authentication method.
- 3. Click the Log on button. The page below will appear, prompting you to open your second factor authentication application, either RSA or Microsoft Authenticator.

Page 2: Second Factor Authentication – Entra ID Microsoft Authenticator Users


Note: The steps below are for Entra ID users who use the Microsoft Authenticator app.

The screen below will be displayed briefly.





The screen will change to a screen requesting your Microsoft verification code:




- 1. Enter the six-digit code presented in the Microsoft Authenticator app.
- 2. Click Log On.

Page 2: Second Factor Authentication – RSA Users

Note: The steps below are only for non-migrated users, who use RSA.

The screen below will be displayed, requesting your RSA Passcode.



- 1. Enter your personal pin followed by the six-digit code presented in the RSA app.
- 2. Click Log On.
