RE: Proposed Change to Release of Unused Firm Transmission Capacity in Real Time

Heartland Generation Ltd. (Heartland) is an independent power producer with thermal generating assets in both Alberta and British Columbia. Heartland supports the proposal to amend Section 4.1 of the Posting of Transmission Service Offerings Business Practice to facilitate access to U.S. markets.¹

BC Hydro's unused firm transmission capacity is not released in time for exporters to reliably trade with US markets, which creates unnecessary difficulty and uncertainty for both the exporters themselves and the associated balancing authorities. The proposal to release BC Hydro's unused firm transmission capacity at T-85 instead of T-60 would correct this deficiency and foster open, non-discriminatory access to US markets.
