Re: Proposed Change to Counterflow

Dear Ms. Ambrosi,

On April 30, 2021, a BC Hydro bulletin noted that “BC Hydro Power Supply (BCPS) requests that BC Hydro Grid Operations (Transmission Provider) modify BC Hydro’s ATC Implementation Document (ATCID) and associated TTC/ATC Business Practice to allow for firm counter-flow scheduling from BC to the U.S. based on the assured deliveries of the Canadian Entitlement.”

Evolugen operates 170MW of hydro facilities in British Columbia, and actively markets electricity on the interties as a BC Hydro transmission customer. We support an open and transparent transmission system, where customers are treated equally and fairly, to compete via market signals in accordance with the Open Access Transmission Tariff. Evolgen recommends that the increase of firm ATC on the export path to the U.S. border, should the BCPS Proposal be accepted, be accessible with fair and equal notice to all transmission customers. As an active market participant, Evolgen would also appreciate more clarity and information from BC Hydro on how transmission rights associated with the Canadian Entitlement are released to market.
