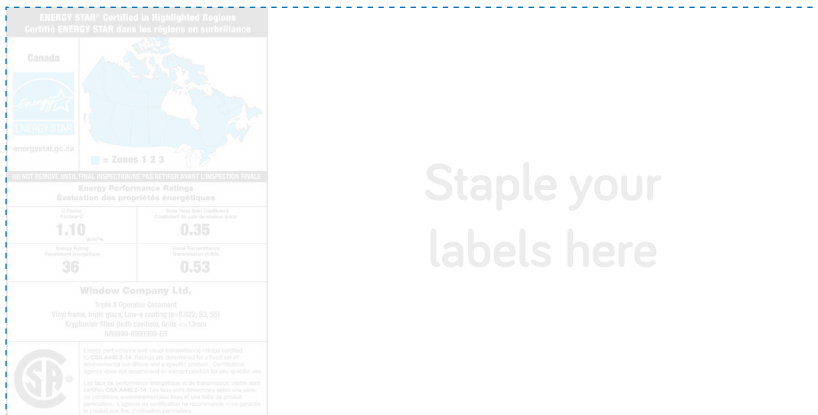

*Note: a City of Vancouver bylaw requires replacement windows to have a U-Factor that meets Tier 1 requirements; therefore, City of Vancouver residences are only eligible for Tier 2 rebates.
