
## Insulation invoice requirements

Your insulation invoice needs to have all the information identified below in order to meet the documentation requirements for the Home Renovation Rebate Program and CleanBC Home Efficiency Rebates.



- 1 Contractor's company name & address
- 2 Contractor's contact information
- 3 Invoice number & contractor GST number
- 4 Invoice date
- 5 Participant name & address
- In each area of the house that has been upgraded and/or had a different insulation treatment, indicate the following:
  - a Location of installation (attic; wall cavities; wall sheating; basement/ crawlspace walls; exposed floor; joist header; crawlspace, etc.)
  - b Starting and final R-value
  - c Total amount added in square feet
- 7 Cost (including labour)
- Proof of payment or payment plan (e.g. PAID stamp)
