

BC Hydro Power Smart for Schools Electrical Safety Week Contest (the “Contest”) Terms and Conditions

- 1) **Eligibility.** No purchase necessary. This Contest is open to teachers and parents in British Columbia, aged 19 years or over, who participate in the Power Smart for Schools Safety Street activity between **May 1, 2021 and May 31, 2021**. BC Hydro employees, their respective affiliates, and family members living with employees of BC Hydro are encouraged to participate but not eligible to enter the contest.
- 2) **How to Enter.** Visit <https://schools.bchydro.com> and complete the Safety Street interactive video and quiz between **May 1, 2021 8:00 a.m. PST and May 31, 2021 4:00 p.m. PST** to be entered into the prize draw. Limit one contest entry per person per week, which will be eligible for the weekly prize draw. All contest entries will be collected by BC Hydro and a weekly random draw to determine the winning contest entrant will take place on or around **May 10, 17, 24, 31, 2021**.
- 3) **Prize.** There is one prize package to be won each week, a total of four prize packages will be given between **May 1, 2021 and May 31, 2021**. The prize package contains a drawstring bag, pen, water bottle, notebook, cardboard bus, skipping rope, bike light, reflective keychain. For contest winners who are parents, one prize package will be provided for their child, for contest winners who are teachers, one prize package will be provided for each student. Total approximate value of the prize is \$150 CAD. The prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, non-refundable and not convertible to cash. BC Hydro reserves the right to substitute a prize of equivalent retail value if any component of the prize cannot be awarded as described. Only one prize package may be won by any entrant of this Contest.
- 4) **Prize Draw.** Four random prize draws will take place on or around **May 10, 17, 24, 31, 2021**. No correspondence will be entered into except with the eligible winner, who will be notified by email on or around **May 10, 17, 24, 31, 2021**. At least two (2) attempts over five (5) business days will be made to contact the eligible winner by email. If the eligible prize winner cannot be contacted by email, he, she, or they will be disqualified and a second contest entrant will be selected via random draw.
- 5) **Consent.** By entering the Contest, all entrants agree and consent to the use of their personal contact information (name, email) for the purposes of contacting the winning contest entrant for the purposes of administering the prize.
- 6) **Warranties.** By entering, you represent, warrant and confirm that:
 - a) Your Contest entry is automatic by signing in or signing up for a Power Smart for Schools account and participating in the interactive Safety Street video;
 - b) No other person or entity other than you has any right, title or interest in any part of your entry;
 - c) Your entry, the use thereof by BC Hydro, or the exercise by BC Hydro of any of the rights granted by you under these Contest Rules does not and will not infringe or violate any rights of any third party or entity, including, without limitation patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret, defamation, privacy, publicity, false light, misappropriation, intentional or negligent infliction of emotional distress, confidentiality, or any contractual or other rights;

- 7) **Disqualification.** BC Hydro reserves the immediate right to disqualify any entry that they deem in their sole discretion: (i) is not in compliance with these Contest Rules, or (ii) tampers with the contest in any way.
- 8) **Decisions Final.** Decisions by BC Hydro in respect of all aspects of this Contest, including but not limited to the eligibility of entries, are final. In the event of a dispute regarding identity of the entrant, the entry will be deemed submitted by the holder of the associated e-mail account. BC Hydro will be free from any liability occurring as a result of the prize being awarded or the use of the prize.
- 9) **Limitation of Liability.** By entering this Contest, all entrants agree to release, discharge and hold harmless BC Hydro and their respective partners, affiliates, advertising/promotional agencies, and their employees, officers, directors, representatives and assigns from any claims, losses and

damages arising out of their participation in this Contest, and the acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of the prize awarded hereunder. BC Hydro, or any of their employees, officers, directors, agents, contractors, representatives, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising/promotion agencies do not assume responsibility whatsoever for delayed, failed, partial or garbled computer transmissions; technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited to lost, interrupted or unavailable network server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website or other connections, available or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone, fax or cable transmissions, lines or technical failures or difficulties; the incorrect or inaccurate capture or failure to capture information whether caused by the site users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or other information; the failure to capture any such information; errors of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronics, network or otherwise arising out of or relating to the Contest; theft, lost, destruction or damage to entries, in whole or in part; or other factors beyond their reasonable control.

This Contest is subject to all federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The sole jurisdiction to resolve any disputes concerning this Contest is the Province of British Columbia.

12) **Privacy.** BC Hydro will use the personal information submitted with the entry for the purpose of administering the Contest prize. Personal information will be detached, and stored separately from your survey answers. For the purpose of the above, "personal information" only includes the first name, last name, email address and phone number of the entrant. BC Hydro is collecting this personal information and running the Contest in furtherance of its conservation mandate under the *Clean Energy Act*.
