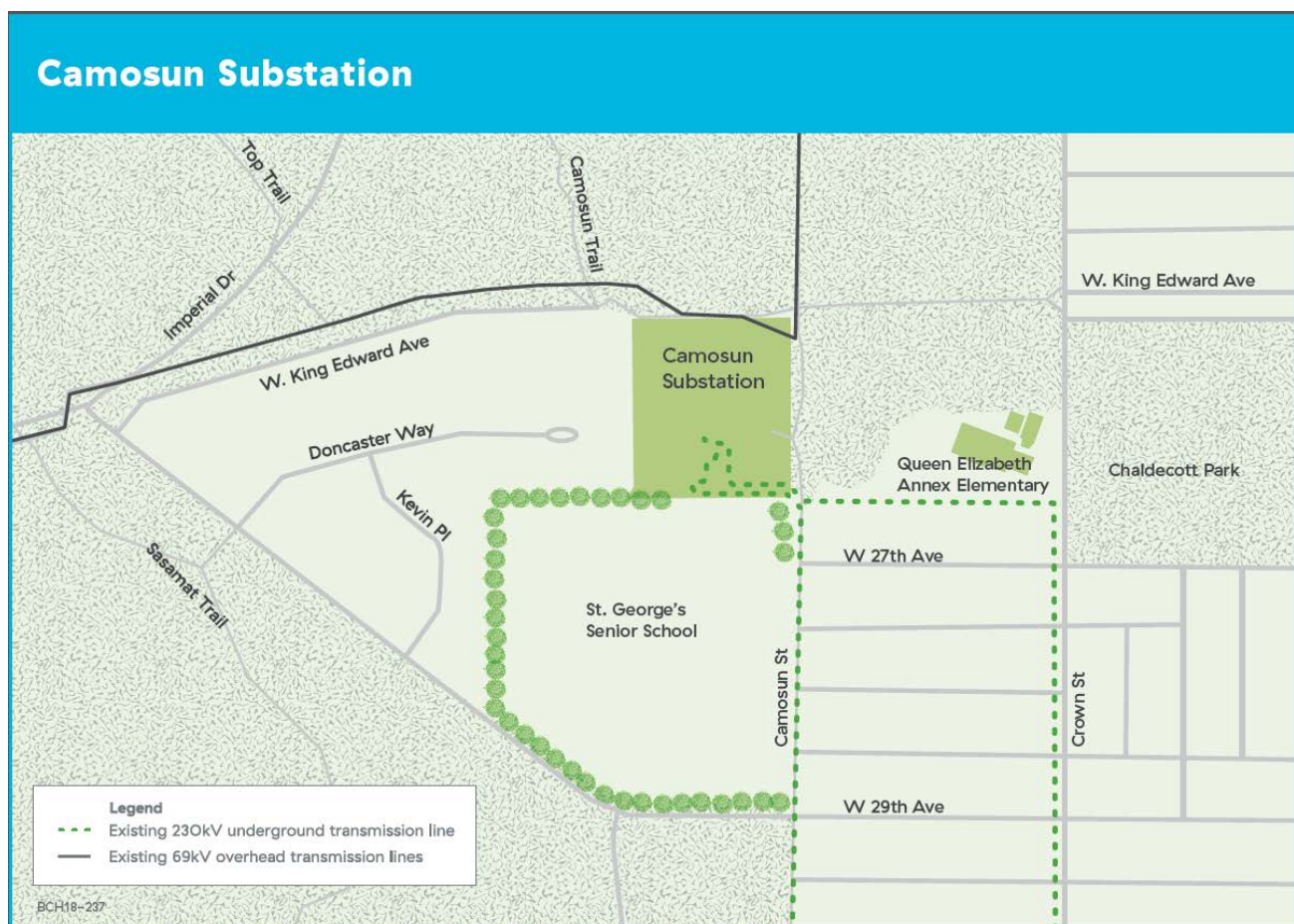

## Camosun Substation Upgrade Project

Dear Neighbour,

To continue to reliably meet the growing demand for electricity on the west side of Vancouver we will be upgrading the Camosun Substation later this year. This substation is an integral part of our electricity system in the Lower Mainland and serves over 23,500 customers west of Blenheim Street.



### Why are we doing this work?

The Camosun Substation, built in the 1960's, is reaching capacity and some components are in need of replacement. Concurrently, significant upgrades are being made at the substation to support the growing community at the University of British Columbia's

Vancouver campus. This work will ensure continued electricity supply to all our customers connected to this substation, improved safety for our workers, and provide the foundation to support growth in the area for years to come.

### **Upcoming Site Preparation Work**


