South Fraser Transmission Relocation

This April, we're starting the next stage of work in approved rights-of-way in Delta and Richmond and on Deas Island to prepare for the relocation of our transmission line out of the George Massey Tunnel. This transmission line is a critical part of our network, supplying power to tens of thousands of customers in Delta, Richmond and other parts of the Lower Mainland.

This spring, crews will install the foundations for the new transmission structures. This work will take approximately eight months and follows the temporary works and vegetation clearing that began in November 2016.

Traffic flaggers, signage and pedestrian barriers are in place to establish safe work areas. Most work is anticipated to take place between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Saturday, consistent with local noise bylaws. Notification will be provided prior to work conducted outside of the hours noted above. To ensure your safety and that of our crews, please follow any posted construction signage or direction provided by the on-site crews during this work. Thank you for your co-operation.
