

# John Hart Generating Station Replacement Project

## SECOND ANNUAL COMMUNITY SITE EVENT

**Date:** Sunday, July 17, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

BC Hydro and InPower BC, the project contractor, are pleased to invite you to the second annual John Hart Generating Station Replacement Project community event – a unique annual opportunity to see the construction site and watch the project evolve through 2018.

Come and see the exciting work on this legacy project for Campbell River and BC Hydro!

## HOW TO GET THERE:

The only permitted way to get to the site is by our free passenger bus service.

- Passenger pick-up on Shoppers Row, directly in front of Spirit Square, will run approximately every 10 minutes beginning at 9:30 a.m. until about 2:30 p.m.
- A continuous loop will run from Shoppers Row to the two construction site locations (at the underground portals and John Hart dam) to the interpretive centre area, and then back downtown.
- The project team will have a tour guide on each bus.

## SAFETY AROUND THE CONSTRUCTION SITE:

Construction activity will be shut down for this event so people can walk around the defined areas (there will be no access into the underground tunnels), and see the unique construction equipment on display.

- People at all times must stay within designated safe areas and not go beyond fenced off areas. This is for your own safety.
- Appropriate footwear is strongly recommended given the uneven surface.
- We also encourage the use of sunscreen.

Project staff will be wearing safety vests and will be guiding you on the project overviews and be pleased to answer your questions.

## EVENT ACTIVITIES:

Scheduled activities include a tour at the construction site, displays and activities at the interpretive centre area including the Museum at Campbell River, a puppet show and crafts, barbecue provided by the Kinsmen club, community booth displays and bucket rides in a BC Hydro line truck. Plus, the John Hart Project Interpretive Centre will be open to provide more project info.

## IT'S GOING TO BE A BUSY DAY:

The John Hart project is popular across Vancouver Island. It is difficult to gauge and prepare for the number of people that may attend – the project team is preparing for up to 2,500 visitors.

The site is not conducive for parking given its narrow orientation and construction areas. If the buses are busy, please be patient and respectful to others. Listen to the tour guide assigned to your bus.

The John Hart project team is looking forward to seeing you on July 17!
