Traffic Advisory

Copper River Forest Service Road bridge replacement

We're replacing the bridge located at the 6.5 km mark on Copper River Forest Service Road, approximately 9 km east of Terrace.

Construction is expected to continue from August through October 2026.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Single-lane alternating traffic
- Temporary traffic holds and full road closures
- Reduced speed limits near active work areas
- Increased construction vehicle activity

Most traffic delays are expected to be less than 30 minutes.



Traffic disruptions are expected on the Copper River Forest Service Road east of Terrace.

Please follow all traffic control signage and directions from traffic control personnel when traveling through the area.

PLANNED FULL ROAD CLOSURES AND DELAYS

Accommodation will be made for emergency personnel throughout all operations.

- **September 3 to 8 (7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.):** Periodic full road closures may occur during bridge component delivery and unloading operations. Wait times are expected to be 30 to 60 minutes.
- **September 8 to 9 (6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.):** Full road closure while new bridge is installed.
- **September 29 to October 1 (6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.):** Full road closures for removal of the existing bridge.

Please obey all road signs and traffic control crews and drive cautiously around near work zones.
