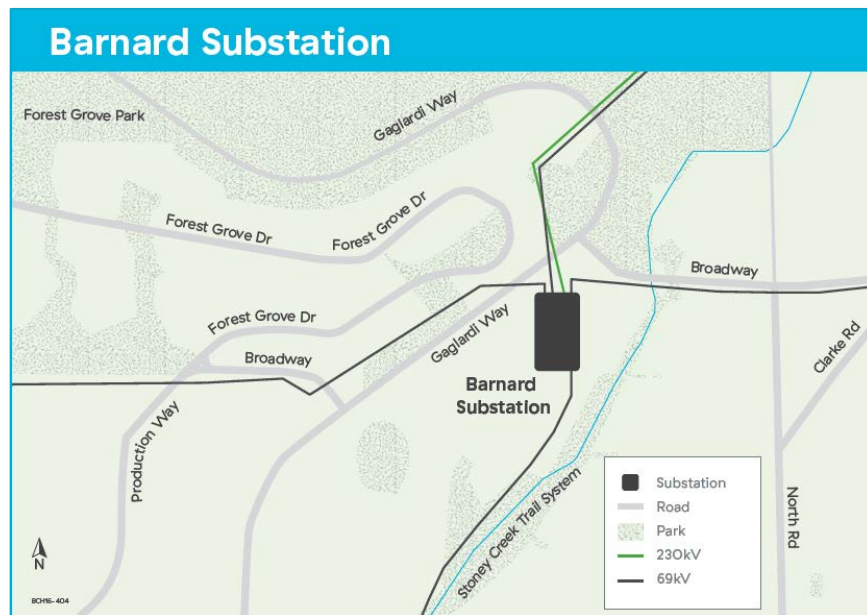

Dear Neighbour,

To meet the growing demand for electricity in Burnaby, we are upgrading the Barnard Substation near Gaglardi Way. This will ensure continued electricity supply to the over 36,000 customers connected to this substation while providing safe access for our workers. The infrastructure being added provides the foundation to support electricity demand for the next two decades.



### How will this benefit you

In addition to the system reliability improvement, this upgrade will improve the look of the substation by replacing some of the lattice structures, also known as feeder sections, with new, smaller equipment within an indoor structure. The other feeder section still has useful lifespan for another couple of decades but will also eventually be replaced. This project is the first of several over next few decades that will modernize the substation. **Construction Schedule**

You may see some early preparation work in fall 2016. The construction is scheduled to begin in summer 2017 for the first phase of the project, involving the construction of a small control building on the northern part of the substation land for new indoor circuit breakers.

We will provide additional detailed notices before any significant construction work starts.

Our work typically takes place between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., consistent with the City of Burnaby's noise bylaws and any granted variances. All work will be done within the substation fence.
