

Newell Substation Upgrade Project Notice of Construction



HIGHLAND PARK LINE TRAIL RELOCATION STARTS JULY 13, 2026

Our general contractor, Graham Construction, will mobilize to site to set up a parking and work area south of the substation along Beresford Street. This will include relocating the Highland Park Line Trail closer to the roadway and erecting construction fencing around the parking and work zone.

What to expect

- Temporary trail closure and detour:
 - The section of the trail between Magnolia Terrace/Mission Avenue and Griffith Drive will be temporarily closed during the trail relocation work.
 - Trail users will be re-directed to the south sidewalk on Beresford Street.
 - Once the trail relocation and set up is complete, the trail will be reopened on the north side of Beresford Street for public use.
- Increased construction traffic: there will be a high volume of construction vehicles on Beresford Street while work is underway.
- Traffic management: please follow the instructions of traffic management personnel on-site that will be directing the safe movement of vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians through the area.
- This work will take approximately three weeks to complete. All work will take place during daytime hours.
- The trail will be returned to its original location at the completion of the project.
