

UPDATED: Construction Notice – Electrical Upgrade Work Fraser Highway, from 149 Street to 170 Street, Surrey

July 9, 2024

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes modifications to some of our existing overhead infrastructure and the installation of new utility poles along Fraser Highway, from 149 St to 170 St in Surrey. This is an update to the notice previously published in May 2024.

From now through to the end of August, crews will install poles, pole equipment, and string power lines using trucks and heavy machinery. Please see page two for a map of the work area.

Where (UPDATED): Fraser Highway, between 149 St and 170 St in Surrey.

When (UPDATED): Now through the end of August 2024.

Working Hours (UPDATED): Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

If planned outages are required to safely complete this work, impacted customers will receive separate outage notifications (postcard, auto-dialer and email) with the outage details.

Safety is our top priority. Sidewalks, bike lanes and bus stops on this route may be impacted and might not be available. Please follow the onsite signage provided by TransLink and the direction of the crew on site.


Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel and posted signage.

This project will ensure that we can continue to provide safe and reliable power to residents and businesses in the Lower Mainland and allow for the safe construction of the SkyTrain around the power lines.
