

Construction Notice

156 Street between 76A Avenue and Fraser Highway, Surrey

March 9, 2026

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes the pole energizations, cable pulling, and the installation and extension of circuits.

Our crews will work on both sides of 156 Street between 76A Avenue and Fraser Highway in Surrey. (see the map on page 2 for the specific location).

Where: 156 Street between 76A Avenue and Fraser Highway, in Surrey.

When: Anticipated to start mid March, with completion by the mid June 2026.



Working Hours: Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Safety is our top priority. Temporary traffic and turning restrictions will be in place along 156 Street to accommodate this work. Traffic may be reduced to a single lane along 156 Street. Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel and posted signage. (see map on page 2).

Sidewalks, bike lanes, and bus stops will be temporarily impacted on 156 Street and may not be available. Please follow the on-site signage provided by TransLink and the direction of the crew on site.
