

## Construction Notice

### 64 Avenue between Fraser Highway and 192 Street, Surrey

July 10, 2026

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes the installation of new electrical poles and a duct bank to accommodate the relocation of power lines along Fraser Highway and adjacent intersections.

Safety is our top priority. Trucks and machinery will travel along 64 Avenue, between Fraser Highway and 192 Street. Construction activity can be expected on-site. This includes crews with heavy equipment, excavation, and open trenches.

**Where:** 64 Avenue between Fraser Highway and 192 Street in Surrey.

**When:** Week of July 13 (initial preparation); work starts August 10, with targeted completion by the end of August.

**Working Hours:** 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

In the week of July 13, we will be working within Surrey Langley SkyTrain road closures. Starting August 10, BC Hydro crews will be working on 64 Ave, with traffic impacts, including a partial closure of 64 Ave at the Fraser Highway intersection, to accommodate open-trench work. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction along 64 Ave with lane disruptions and turning restrictions.

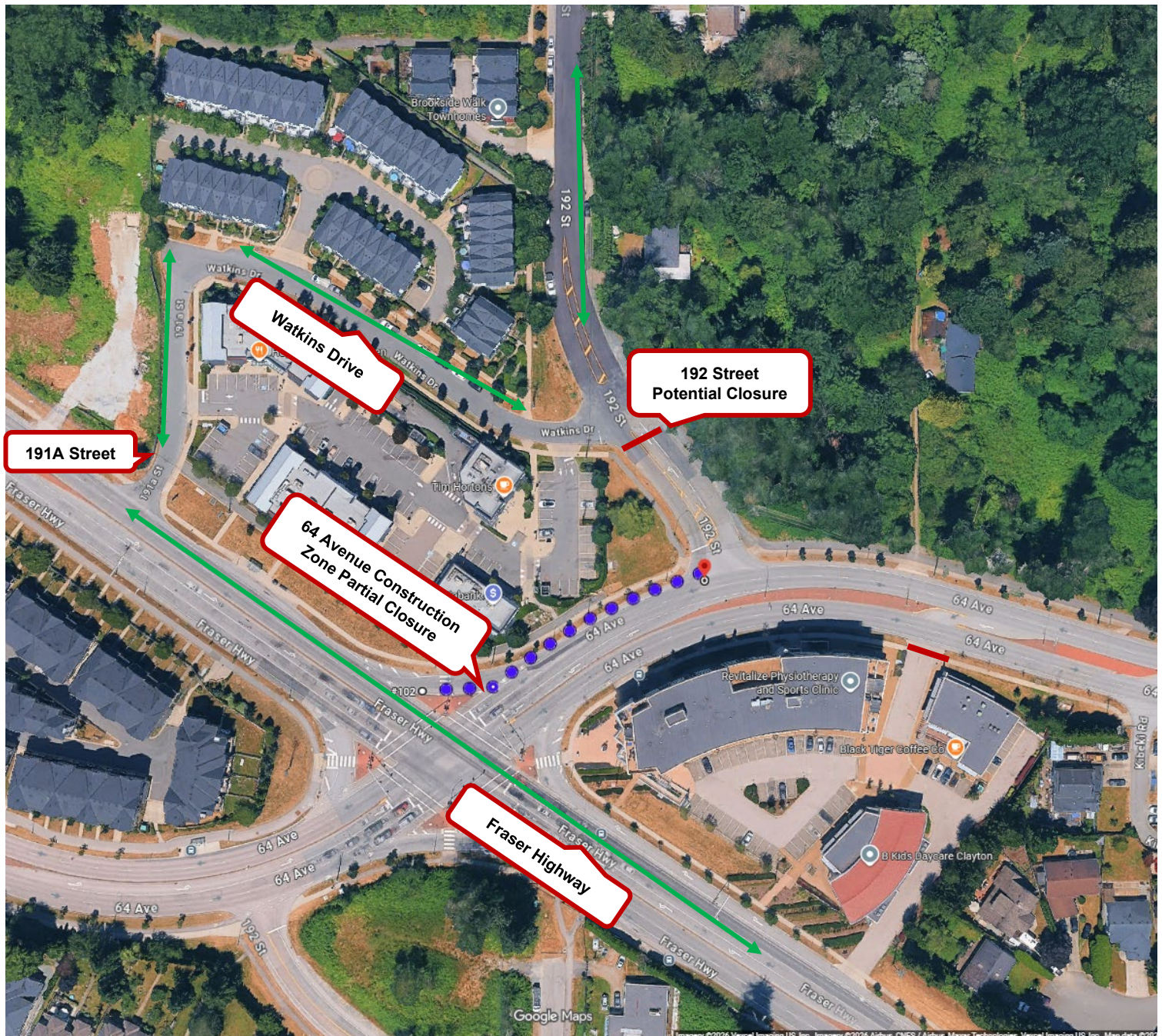
Additionally, our work may result in the potential closure of 192 Street between Watkins Drive & 64 Avenue; details will be shared in an update to this notice once traffic plans are confirmed (map on page 2).

**Detour:** Residential and business access will be maintained from 191A Street and Watkins Drive during the potential closure of 192 Street. Street parking along Watkins Drive will be limited and may not be available.

Business and residential access will be maintained from Fraser Highway. Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel.

Bus stops will be temporarily impacted on Fraser Highway and may not be available. Please follow the on-site signage provided and the on-site crew directions.
