

Construction Notice

Fraser Highway and 196 Street, Langley

April 15, 2026

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes the pole energizations, cable pulling, and the installation and extension of circuits. Our crew will work on the north and west sides of Fraser Highway between Willowbrook Drive & 196A in Langley. (see the map on page 2 for the specific location).

Where: Fraser Highway (east of Willowbrook Drive) and 196 Street, in Langley.

When (UPDATED): Anticipated to start April 20, with completion by May 8, 2026.

Working Hours: Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

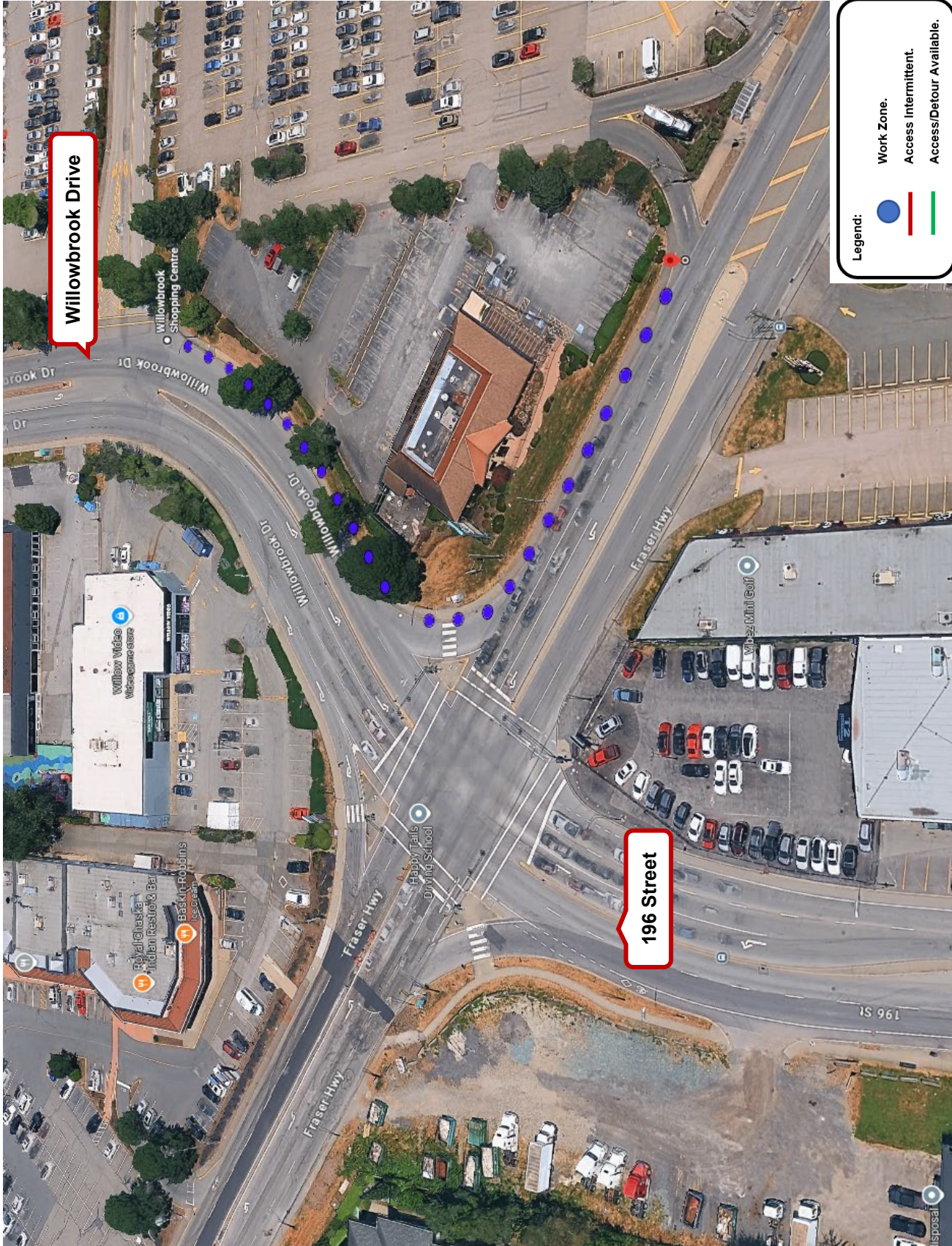
Safety is our top priority. Traffic is reduced to a single lane in each direction along Fraser Highway. Access to the shopping center from Willowbrook Drive will be maintained. Right-lane turn from the shopping center to Fraser Highway, and the pedestrian ramp will be available (see map on page 2).

Bike lanes and bus stops will be temporarily impacted on Fraser Highway and may not be available. Please follow the on-site signage provided by TransLink and the direction of the crew on site.

Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel and posted signage. Cyclists are advised to look for [alternative bike routes](#) while work is underway on Fraser Highway.
