

Construction Notice

Fraser Highway between Quibble Creek Greenway and 140 Street, Surrey

September 4, 2026

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. This work includes the upgrade and installation of new poles, transformer energization, cable pulling and extension of circuits. Our crew will work on the north side of Fraser Highway between Quibble Creek Greenway and 140 Street, in Surrey.

Where: Fraser Highway between Quibble Creek Greenway and 140 Street, in Surrey.

When: Sunday, September 13 and September 14, 2026

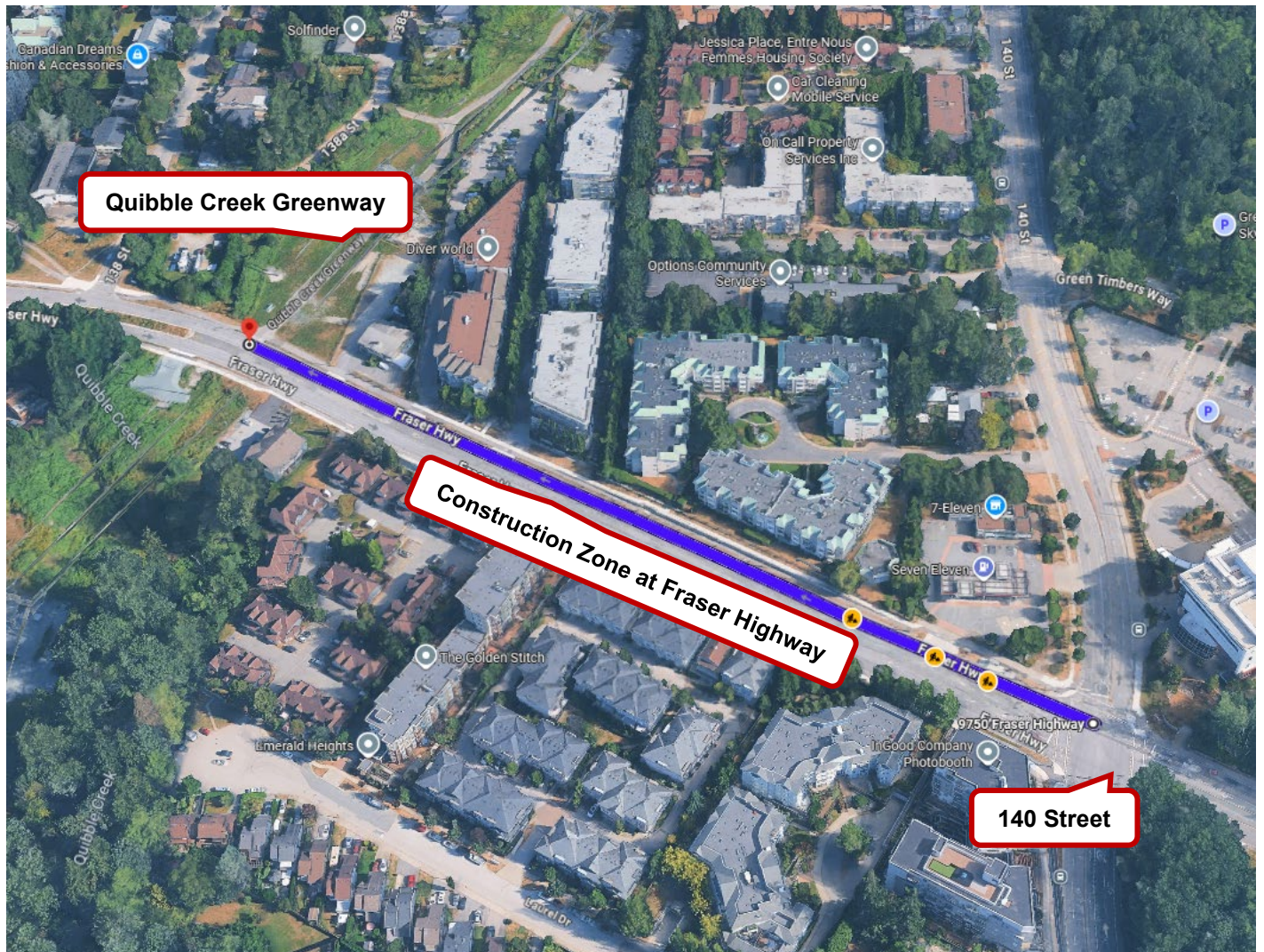
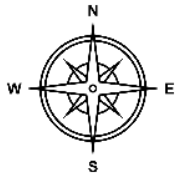
Working Hours: Night Shift, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. (the next day)

Safety is our top priority. Traffic is reduced to a single lane in each direction along Fraser Highway and 140 Street, in Surrey, with temporary lane disruptions and turning restrictions (see map on page 2).

Business and residential access will be maintained from Fraser Highway. Drivers are advised to plan ahead and expect delays. Please reduce speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel.

Bus stops will be temporarily impacted on Fraser Highway and may not be available or relocated while construction is underway. Please follow the on-site signage provided and the on-site crew directions.
