

Construction Notice – Electrical Upgrade Work

192 Street and 64 Avenue, Fraser Highway in Surrey

March 23, 2024

We're working closely with the Surrey Langley SkyTrain Project team to accommodate the rapid transit extension from Surrey to Langley. Survey work will help us determine future electrical upgrades including the installation/relocation of utility poles and ductbanks on 192nd Street and 64th Avenue at Fraser Highway in Surrey.

Work activities include a small concentrated excavation to expose portions of existing utilities and surveying their locations and elevations. See page two for a map of the work area.

Where: 192 St and 64 Ave at Fraser Highway in Surrey.

When: Work starts on March 23, 2024, and is to be completed in the Week of Mach 25.

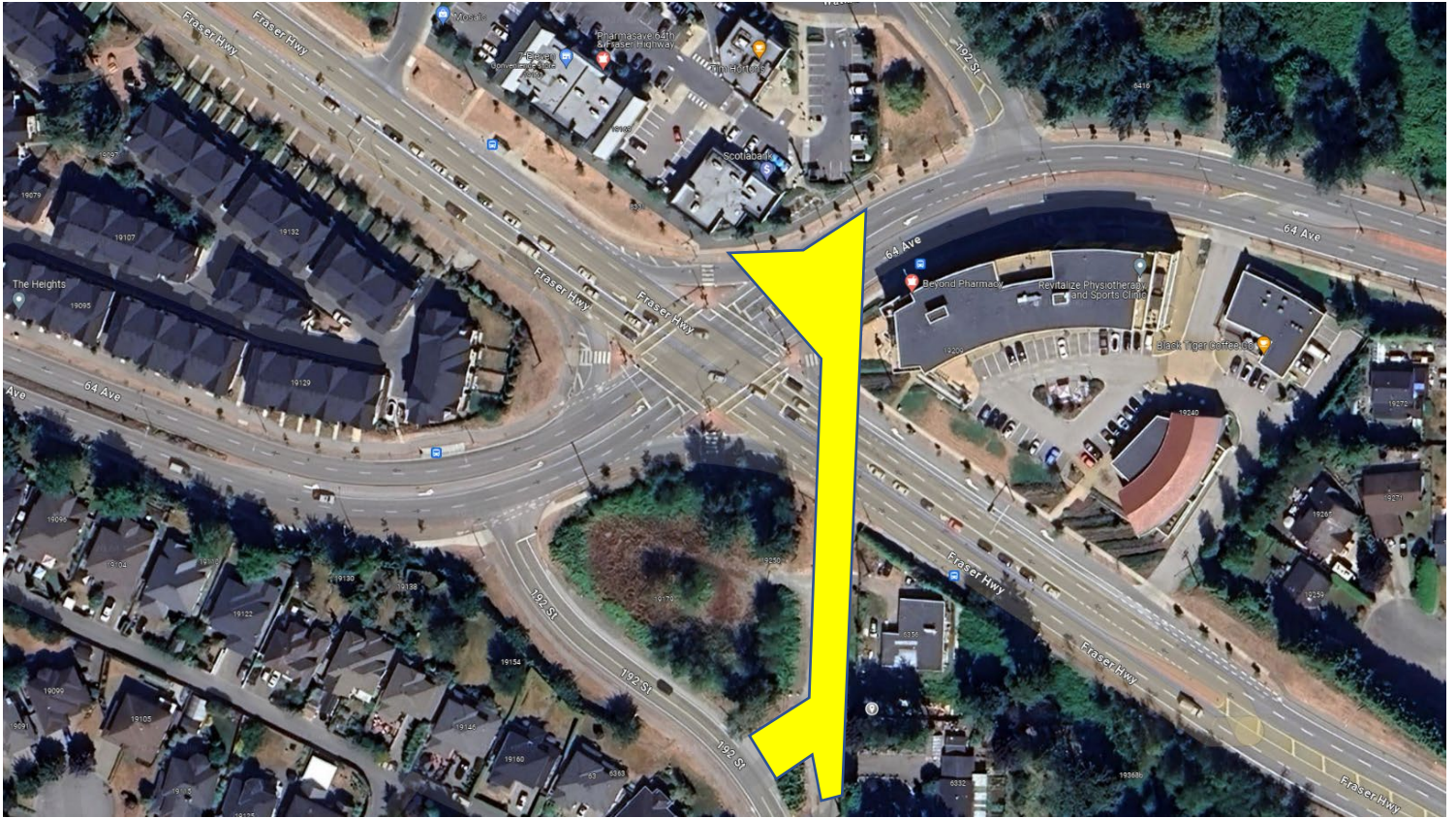
Hours: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m

Safety is our top priority. For this work, we require temporary traffic pattern changes. Please adhere to traffic management on site. To ensure everyone's safety, we advise drivers to reduce their speed in the construction zone and follow the directions of traffic control personnel and posted signage.

This project will ensure that we can continue to provide safe and reliable power to residents and businesses in the Lower Mainland and allow for the safe construction of the SkyTrain around the power lines.
