




West End Substation Update

Dear neighbour,

Further to the investigation we did last year, we'll be drilling up to five more boreholes (each approximately 12 centimetres in diameter) on the Lord Roberts Annex property to gain a full picture of the subsurface conditions. This will help inform our work when we start substation design.

Workers are scheduled to be at the Lord Roberts Annex property between **July 15th and August 16th**. Each borehole will be drilled and restored one at a time at the approximate locations shown on the map below. All activities will be confined to the Lord Roberts Annex property, with the playground remaining open.

Residents and park users can expect the following:

- Work will occur Monday to Friday, 7:30am to 5:00pm. There will be no work on holidays.
- The first week will be used to set-up fencing and equipment.
- Drilling is expected to begin the second week.
- Noise-mitigation, including sound-fencing and sound-monitoring will be in place around each borehole work area during active drilling, to ensure we remain consistent with City of Vancouver noise bylaws.
- The playground will stay open for the duration of this work, with fencing to safely separate the playground and our work area.
- Access to the school yard (excluding the playground) will be restricted for the duration of work.
- Access to the parking lot will be restricted Monday through Friday, but not during the weekend, for example during the Farmers Market.
- The area will be restored after completion of the work.
