Topics of discussion

1: Introductions

Members of the committee introduced themselves and spoke about why they had chosen to participate. Many shared that they live in proximity to the substation site and that they want to ensure that community perspectives are heard and considered. Members also discussed other changes occurring in the West End neighbourhood.

2: West End Substation context

Andrew re-introduced the Project and spoke about why a new substation is needed, how the project site was selected, work that has been completed to date, and the work that will be completed between now and the start of construction.

3. Work planning

Fay shared key activities anticipated during the first six months of construction and committee members indicated a desire to focus on these, and anticipated impacts and mitigations, at this time.

Members indicated several topics of interest: trees, construction traffic management, construction impacts (noise and dust), playground impacts and community communications.

Members agreed to meet monthly to 2027 and prefer in-person meetings in the short-term.

- BC Hydro to plan next committee meeting with a focus on the start of construction
