Notice of upcoming work


Friday, November 21, 2025 7.30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

On November 21, 2025, BC Hydro and the Vancouver School Board will excavate a portion of Nelson Street sidewalk and a small area of the school property.

We'll work in the south sidewalk of Nelson Street, near the intersection with Bute Street, and may move inside the school fence. The east-bound lane of Nelson Street will be closed so we can work safely.

We're doing this work to better understand where tree roots are growing so that we can make efforts to preserve and protect trees during substation and school construction. An arborist will be onsite to oversee the work, and we'll use an 'air vac', which uses air to move soil, to complete this investigative work without damaging any roots.

You'll be able to access Nelson Park, the dog park, and the school playground throughout our work.



What you'll see

On Friday, you'll see our contractor:

- Set up traffic management to close the work area,
- Fence off the area of the sidewalk they'll be working in,
- Remove the sidewalk covering,
- Set up the airvac and use it to remove soil,
- Refill any excavated areas and cover them,
- Tidy up the area.

Planning travel

If you would typically use the sidewalk in our work area, consider:

- Crossing to the north sidewalk, or
- Walking through Nelson Park.

If you expect to drive, to continue eastward, consider diverting to:

- Barclay Street via Bute Street, or
- Comox Street via Bute Street.
